Meltdown solid By Morton Friedman This book follows previous Celebrity Meltdowns, contains 9 highly colored, double panel pop-ups, each with pull tabs and movable action, some of which I've never seen before.

Mel Gibson has continuously running feet; Brittany gets a 4-way joystick; McConaughy has good, 4-way action; Naomi Cambell has nice action, both pop-up and pull tab; Nicole Richie crosses the fold (with difficulty); Keith Richard gets a large, 2-stage pop-up; Cheney is made mean, instead of just stupid; the "3 girls gone wild" shows alot more modesty than the girls showed. The texts are well written and funny, written with a glib vernacular. A fun book, if you don't mind giving undeserving celebrities even more exposure. Caution: On first opening, the pop-ups tend to stick to the glossy pages, which would cause them to tear, so open carefully. When viewed, the book should be fully open, both pages in the same plane for smoothest action.
