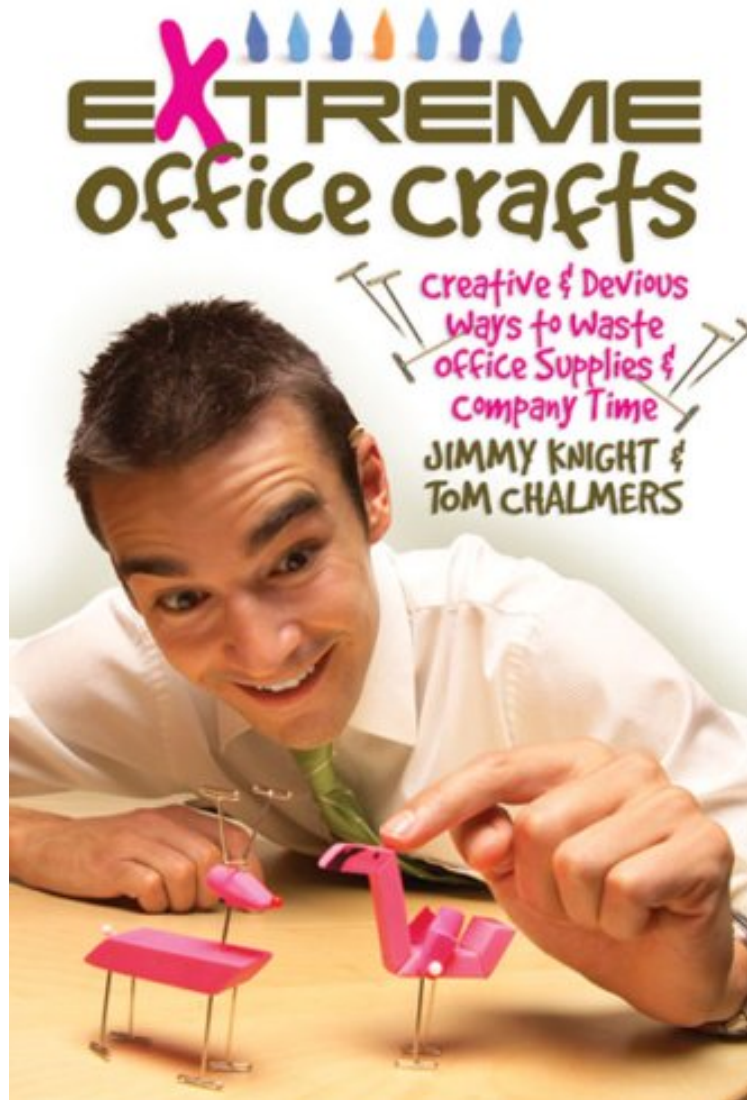

professional one. It's great fun to read and most project instructions include plenty of photos of the different steps so they are easy to follow. There were a few I really liked, generally the smaller crafts involving more common supplies like eraser animals and paper clip jewelry. I felt a number of the crafts were a lot more ambitious than most people would be willing to attempt, like the sticky note mosaic and push pin art cork board. A few others required a lot of time and supplies or produced a finished piece that wouldn't fit in to a professional office environment.
