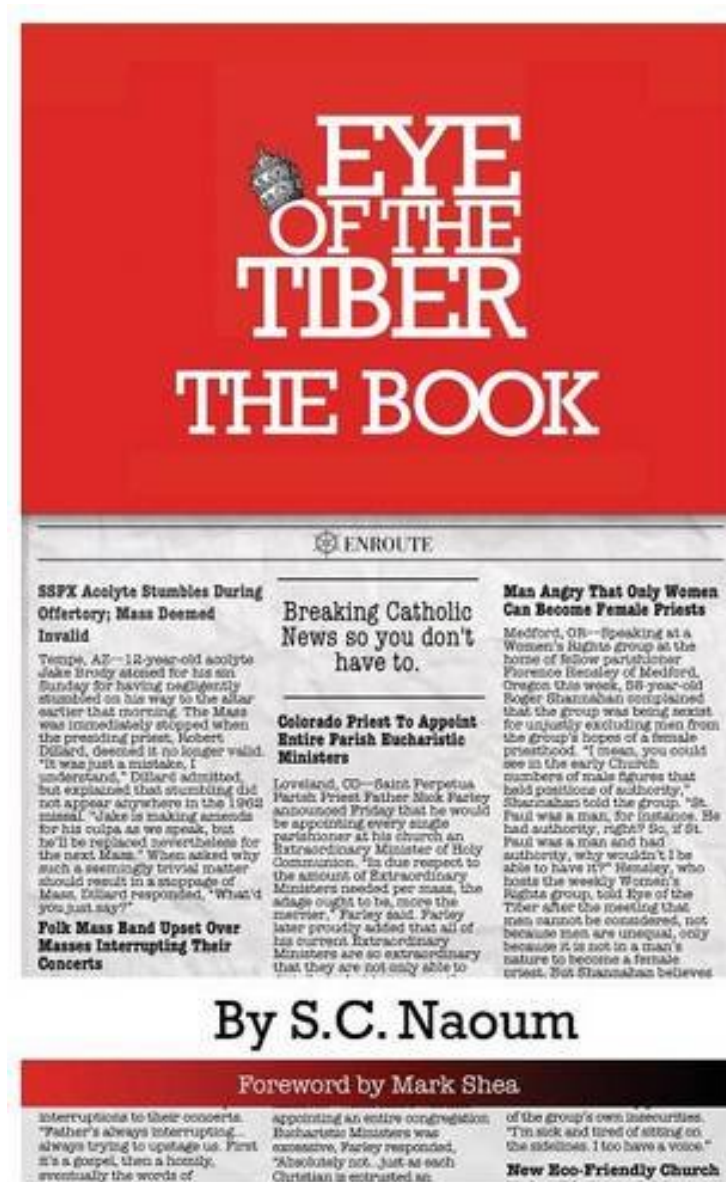


# Eye of the Tiber
