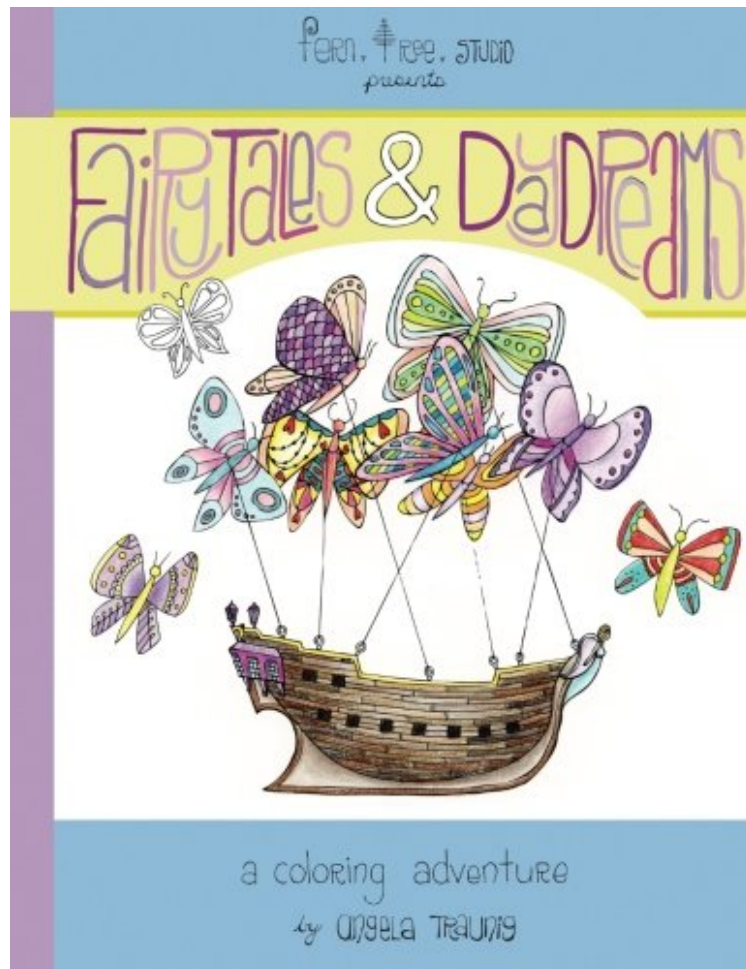

It is glue bound on the left, and non-perforated. The cover is colorful and eye pleasing. The back cover shows one of the illustrations from the inside. The front page includes copyright information and links to other sites and pages to see her work, fan page, and coloring group. The 2nd page is a "belong to" page for the colorist to put their name and can be colored as well.The book contains 30 whimsical images. They are printed on 1 side of the paper only. This is a must for serious colorists. Image quality is nice with clean lines and no fuzzy edges. The illustrations are mostly full page. Some have black borders around them and others do not. There is approximately 1/4 to 1/2 inch white space margin minimum around the images to give you sufficient space to photocopy without losing part of the illustration or

remove with Exacto knife for framing. There are some extra pages in the back to test your colors, doodling your own ideas about fairytales and daydreams, and some blotter pages to help against bleed through. There is also an artist "about me" page. Paper weight is about medium, which is standard for most adult coloring books. You can use crayons, pencils, markers, and gel pens. If you use markers, you will want to put a few sheets of paper behind your image to help prevent possible bleed through issues to the next page. For those that like to use watercolors, I recommend copying to a heavier weight paper, such as: 110 lb weight card stock, mixed media or watercolor paper. This will keep the water from damaging the paper. Most adult coloring book paper is not thick enough to stand up to water. Since I normally use watercolors, I am used to having to copy to thicker paper. This doesn't bother me at all. Illustrations are detailed and several with intricate areas. The author suggests this for ages 12 and above. Those with vision or dexterity issues may have some difficulty with some pages, however, some of the intricate areas can be colored as a whole instead of each individual spot, making it easier to color. I have arthritis in my hands and some vision issues, and the intricate areas here, would not prevent me from buying this book.
