Sweeney A sturdy, colorful cardboard box holds 5 posters of Steve McDonald's FANTASTIC CITIES drawings. Actually four of them are actually from the book, and one is an exclusive drawing released in the recent Fantastic Cities 2017 Wall Calendar: A Coloring Calendar of Amazing Places Real and Imagined. Each poster is 20" x 20" with only a small white border at the bottom for the title; the drawing runs right up to the edge of the paper on the other three sides. The posters are Paris, New York, London, Toronto, and Tokyo and in McDonald's usual style they could go in any number of directions for the colorist - incredible detail, abstraction, creative treatment with light and shadow or additions. The only reason I am not Five Stars on this one is that this is same weight of paper as in the coloring books. I had really hoped for something a little more substantial to handle wet media or alcohol-based markers. Even though these are single-sided with nothing on the other side to be spoiled by bleed-through, a heavier-weight would prevent buckling and allow the posters to be stretched for watercolors and the like.
