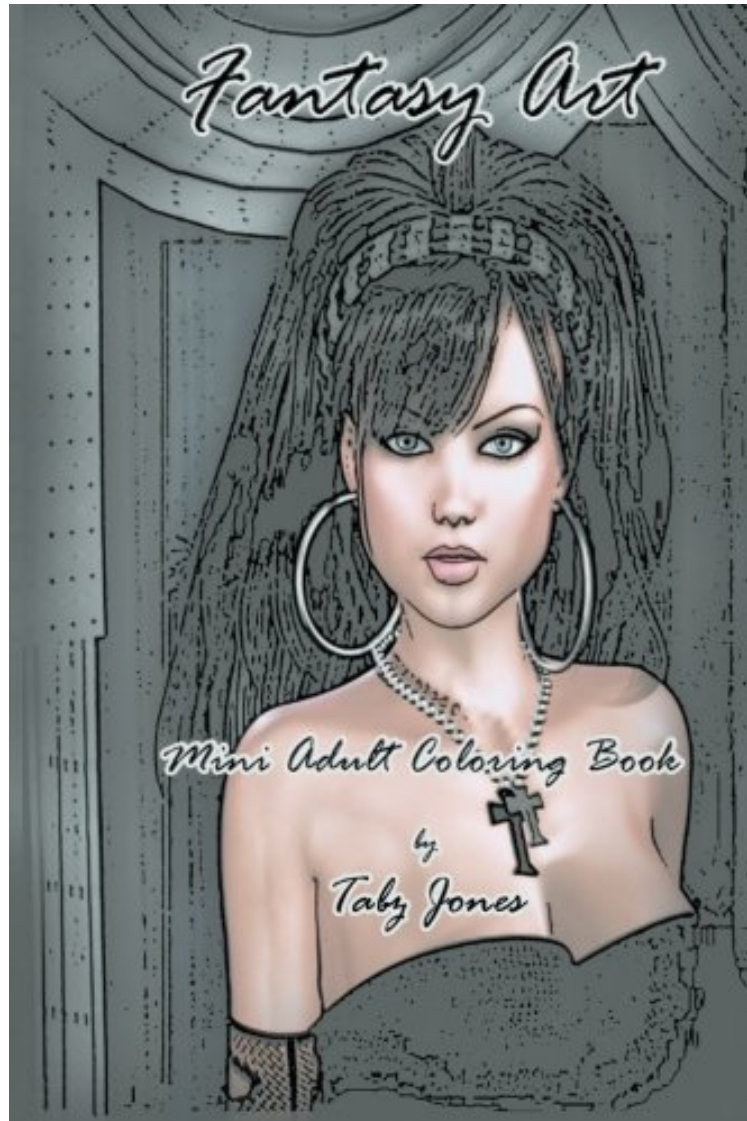

Also, there are new techniques for blending colored pencils such as using baby oil and petroleum jelly that can completely washout lighter pages. I have tried to include a variety of shades to accommodate every skill level, from beginners to advanced in every book that I create. I encourage you to step outside your comfort zone and try something new, I hope that you will be pleasantly surprised by what you can create =)
