Come down to the farm and look around--there are so many new babies to see! Golden ducklings by the puddles and ponds; woolly lambs so cute and soft; pink piglets that lie in the long, cool grass; and furry kittens curled in cozy corners. Chirpy chicks nuzzle Mama Hen's feathers, the gentle foal gallops alongside Mother, and curious Puppy heads out to explore--but the new calf still wobbles when he walks and can't go far. What fun they all are!

From School Library JournalPreSchool-These simple books can be shared in a lap-sit between adult and child, or enjoyed alone by preschoolers. Texts and small illustrations are on the left, and a full-page picture appears on the right. The minimal narratives include the kind of baby ("Kitten"), a sentence about it ("A baby cat is called a kitten"), and a sentence describing the large illustration. ("After playing outside, this little kitten has found a cozy place in the barn for a rest.") Eight babies are pictured in each book. Big Babies illustrates African animals, with the exception of a bear and panda. Farm Babies includes both small (kitten and puppy) and large (calf and foal) animals. Those in Small Babies are backyard favorites, pets, and a koala. The watercolor paintings are softened with smudged pencil outlines and shading. The result is warm and cuddly creatures that more closely resemble stuffed toys than their real
