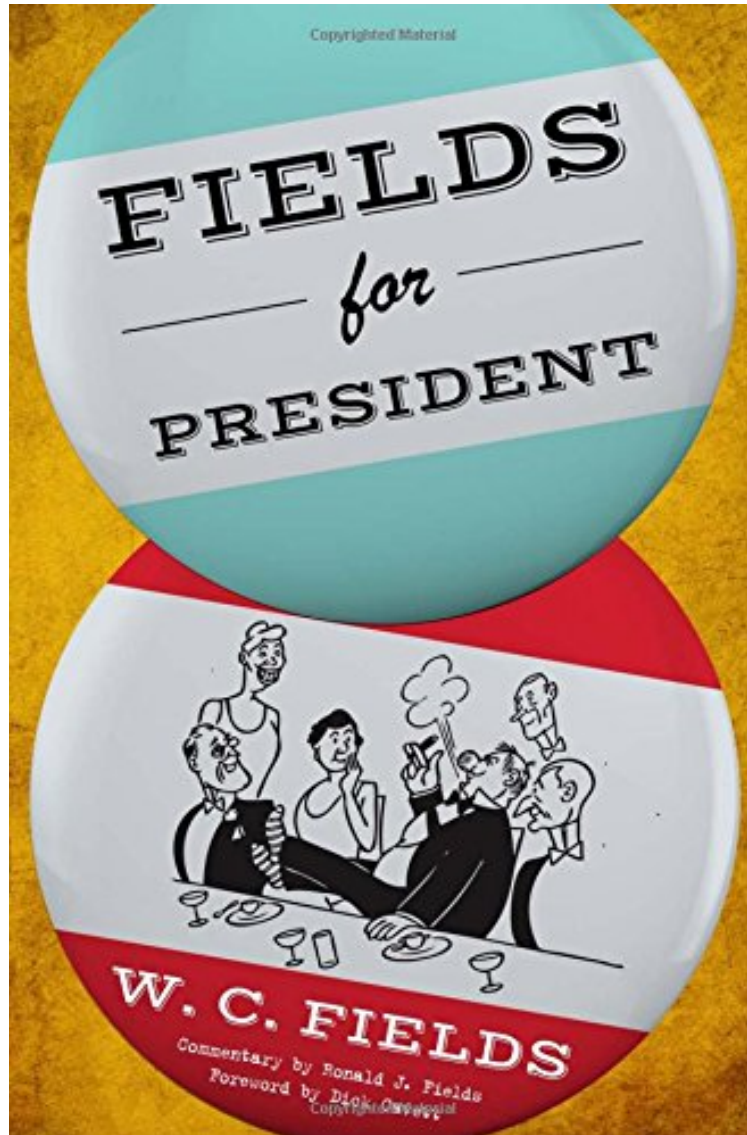

Eventually, he began to incorporate comedy into his act and went on to become a star in the Broadway musical *Poppy*. He had a long and successful career in show business. After his death, his legacy as an entertainer and performer led Woody Allen to dub him one of the six "genuine comic geniuses" in movie history.
