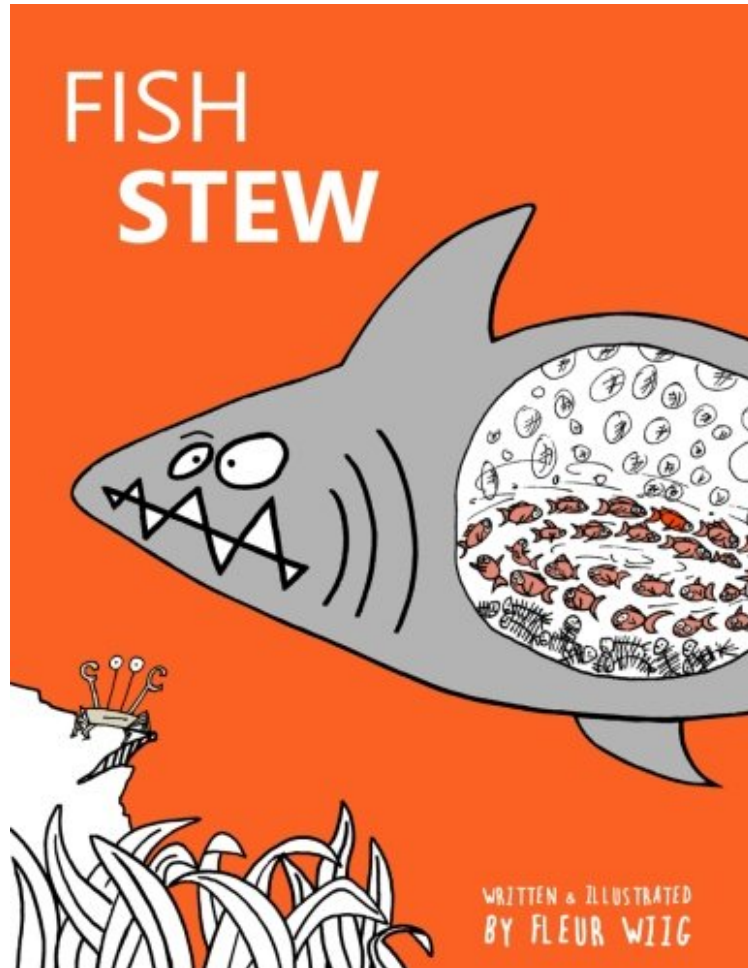

The bold and irreverent illustrations perfectly complement the jaunty rhythm, flavorful rhymes and near rhymes that helped the kids predict what's around the corner for the pescatarian protagonist. This tale especially appeals to the more reserved kids, although everyone can relate to Sam's predicament: his instincts tell him his ideas are worthy, but finding the courage to speak up and swim against the tide is what separates Sam from his "school." Subtle messages are at play as Sam prevails, learning not only to trust his own smarts but also to have faith in the ability of others to recognize grand ideas, no matter how humble their source.
