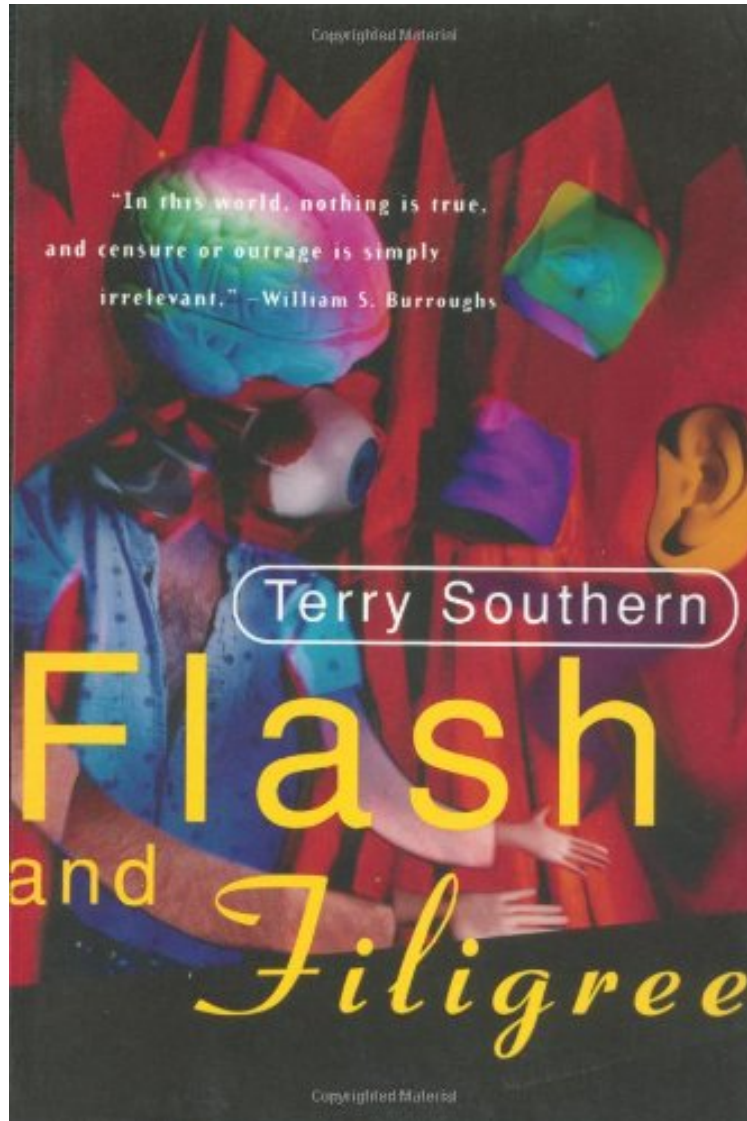

In later years, he wrote for Saturday Night Live and lectured on screenwriting at New York University and Columbia University.
