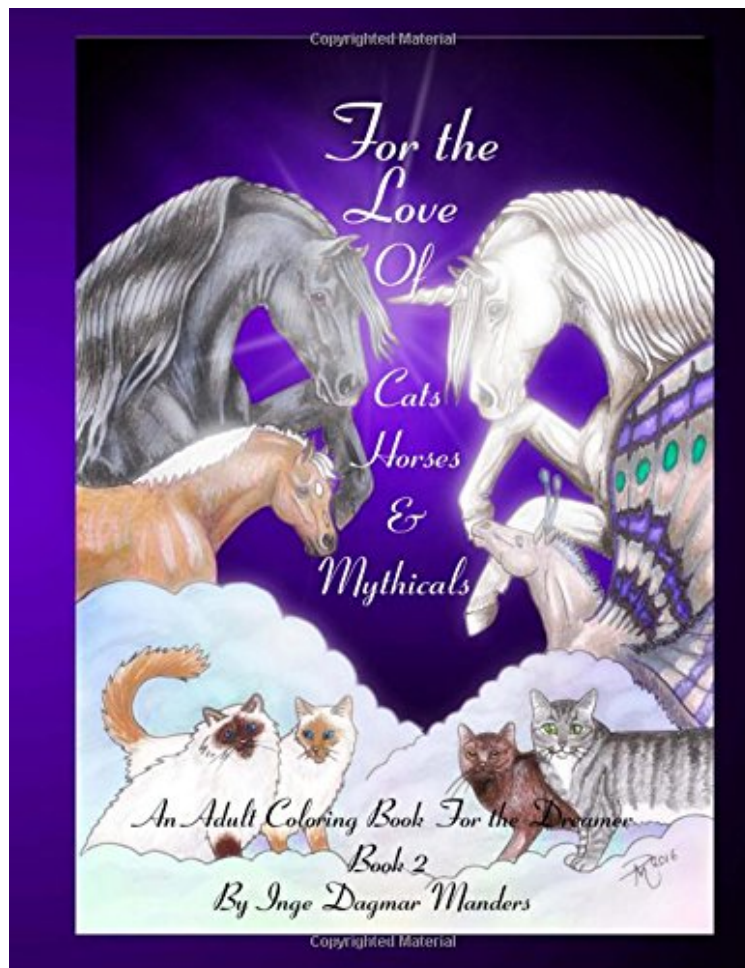

This is filled

with gorgeous, detailed illustrations. Each as nice as the next. You will not be disappointed. This book has an attractive cover with a beautifully colored illustration. The back cover has pictures of 3 smaller illustrations that are in this book, including one with a picture of the 16 panel poster. The poster contains a giant unicorn that is made up from attaching the 16 individual designs. These designs are from Friesian, Arab, and Andalusian horses, to Siamese, Abyssinian and long haired breed cats. Not forgetting the mythical unicorn and pegasus. There is a standard copyright page with a link to where you can find more of the artists work, as well as a colorist "belong to" page that can be colored. In the back of the book are 2 tester pages for you to test your medium on, as well as a special thank you page where she credits her co-admin and coloring team. There are 30 full page images. They all have a thin black border, surrounded by a white space margin. This margin makes it easy for removal for framing or photocopying, without losing part of the image. There are also 7 gray scale images that have been included. At the back of the book are the 16 poster panel pages of illustrations that can be colored separately or colored and attached to make the poster. The poster panel illustrations are not bordered and are not meant to be. Image quality is great. The lines are clear with no fuzzy, pixelated or skipped lines. The illustrations are beautifully detailed. Many are quite elaborate with more intricate areas. Those with dexterity and eye strain/vision problems, like myself, may have some difficulty with some of the pages. However, if you use shorter coloring times, and/or color some of these areas as a whole instead of each small bit, this allows the detail to not be a major issue and you can enjoy this book, as well. That is what I do. So do not let the detail deter you from this book. I have included sample pages for you. Paper is of medium weight which is standard for adult coloring books. You can use most coloring mediums on this. However, if you use markers, put a few blank pieces of paper underneath to help prevent bleed through issues to the next page. If you like using wetter mediums like watercolors, it is advisable to print on to a heavier weight paper, such as 110 lb card stock, mixed media paper or water color paper, to hold up to the water and prevent pilling or tearing issues.
