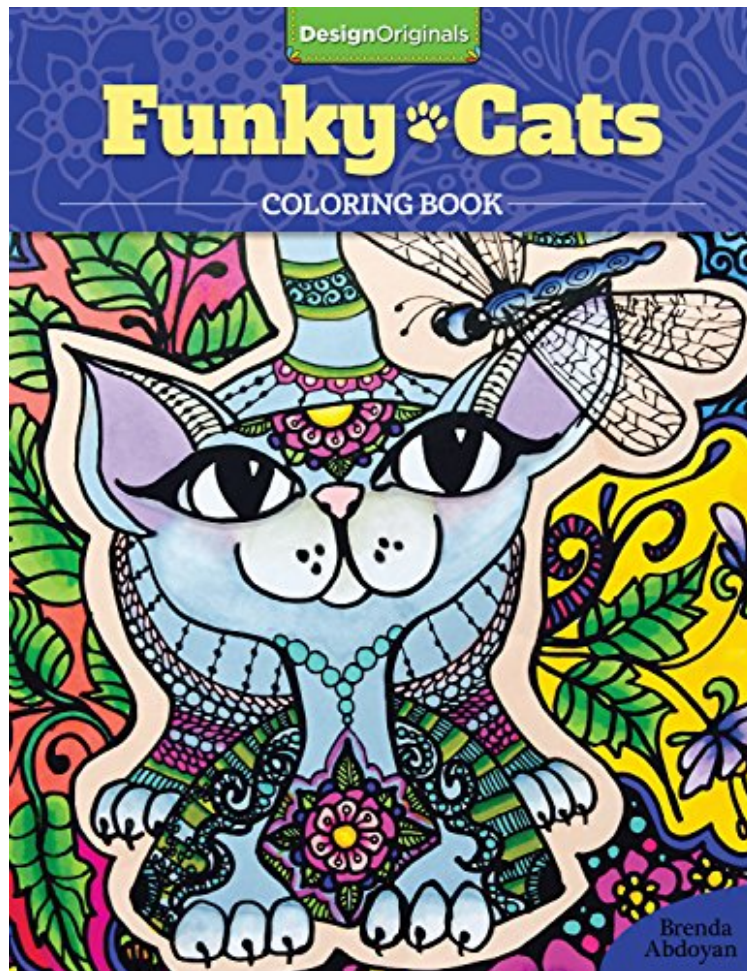

The first five pages are printed in shades of gray but I am assuming that it is an error and not intentional. I am keeping it as I can deal with the lighter tone and I wanted to be able to show those pictures to others so they can see if their copies have a similar issue, i.e., a single printing error or an error in a printing run?On to the book – it has 32 cute titled designs for cat lovers. The cats are in poses that I know that I have seen with my own cats over the years and I suspect others will recognize them as well. For my first project, I chose “Little Miss”. It reminded me of my long ago kitty, Francie. She could always look incredibly adorable just after doing something a tad naughty.The designs are all detailed and have lots of areas for color choices. The artist has a few

pages at the front where she shows examples of various ways of coloring designs (markers versus pencils versus watercolors.) Additionally, there are photos of lots of colored projects for you to see. A little disappointing for me was that there are couple of cats in artwork on the back of the book and on the inside flap of the book which are not included. Hopefully, those will make their way into a second volume down the line. As with other Design Originals Coloring books, this one has a quote and journaling lines on the back of each design page. In this instance, the quotes all have to do with cats and are cute and funny as well. This is what I found in the coloring book: 32 Designs of Cats with lots of abstract and doodle designs. Printed on one side of the page. Paper is medium weight, white, slightly rough to the touch and perforated. Glue Bound. Designs do not cross over the perforations. Artwork has a "frame" around it to give the colorist a natural stopping point. Alcohol and water based markers bleed through the paper. India ink pens bleed through the paper as well. Gel pens do not bleed through. Coloring pencils work well with this paper: soft lead goes on with good color and coverage, layers and blends well; hard lead goes on with fairly good color but leaves dents on the back of the page.

If I could keep only one of the many cat coloring books that I own, it would probably be this one. Everything about this book is wonderful. To begin with, it is a normal size, 8.5" by 11", so when you tear out the pages, they fit on a clipboard. Of course the pages are easy to tear out because they are perforated. The pages are single sided and made of heavy paper. The back side of each page has a quote that is cat-related. That is just an extra perk as far as I am concerned. Each of the pages has a unique drawing of a cat and the cat is properly centered on the page so the design does not run off the page or into the binding. Each cat has a background so there is plenty to color. The designs are a bit funky or whimsical and that makes coloring them even more fun. Most of the designs are of medium detail level and I found plenty of places to use markers, gel pens and of course colored pencils. This book also has plenty of examples of colored pages just in case someone is lacking in imagination.

I bought a copy of this from a family-owned pet-supply store, so I'm not a verified purchaser. I looked for it here, so I could recommend it to another cat-loving coloring enthusiast. Based on just the front cover, I thought this book might be a bit more fanciful and goofy than what I wanted. A quick flip through the pages changed my mind! These cats \*are\* fanciful, and maybe goofy, in a really playful, happy way. The designs and shapes that fill the larger spaces have lots of variety, and just plain LOOK FUN to color. Virtually all of the lines are wide enough that you can get great results, even if your coloring is a tad imprecise, like mine. The kitties range from elegant and regal, to playful and mischievous, and from blissfully napping to ready to pounce. Different breeds are recognizable from the different shapes of faces, eyes, ears, bodies, and coat patterns and lengths. Cats are very expressive creatures, with their eyes being the most important feature in this regard. There are some GREAT EYES in here!! There are 30 colored examples to give you some ideas, as well as a short section about different media and color schemes. I especially love that the artist shows a natural color scheme. I have 2 black cats, and will surely be doing some of these kitties in medium to dark grays and charcoals, with some silver metallic pencil, which on white paper looks dark gray, but adds the luster of highlights. And I'll have to do at least one super-bright rainbow kitty on drab background colors. I really like that each of the drawings has a title, which gives you both some insight into what the artist was thinking, as well as a way to refer to them, besides "that one with the butterfly in the corner". The quotes are fun, too, and even gave me a book title to add to my reading list. Only one tiny downside: Like iiiireader, I too wish the inside-front-cover kitties were colorable images in this book, but they're not. Maybe they're a teaser for Volume 2...??? I hope so!
