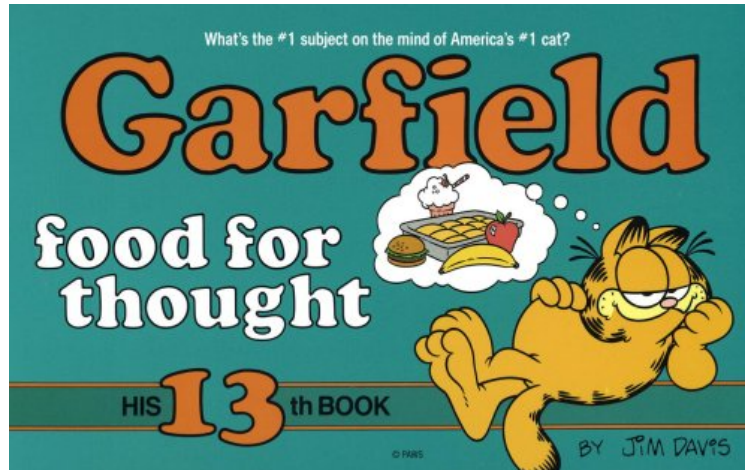

After this book, I got disappointed with Garfield for a while (beginning with a huge dip in quality with Book 14 and going almost 16 books until around Book 30-31). The jokes got tired and re-hashed and un inventive. I got so bored that I didn't collect Garfield for the next 16 or so years...and picked up on the whole collection after college.
