In this case the illustrator is Rick Dupre. And that's the reason I only give the book two stars. Brian Cleary has a wonderful series with Millbrook Press about adverbs, adjectives, nouns, fractions, subtraction etc. - witty verses and hilarious, colorful, bright and cheery illustrations. This book, although the text is the usual witty style of Cleary, is drab, grey, and ugly. The publisher is Lerner Publications. A young child prefers colorful, fun illustrations. Had Cleary illustrated his book I would have purchased it. I have no desire to add this ugly, dreary book to our kids' library. Great job, as usual, Cleary. Publisher, if you want to produce a successful book let the Cleary do what he does best - write for kids and illustrate his own books! Let Dupre express himself artistically elsewhere and keep him away from young children's books until he becomes a better artist.
