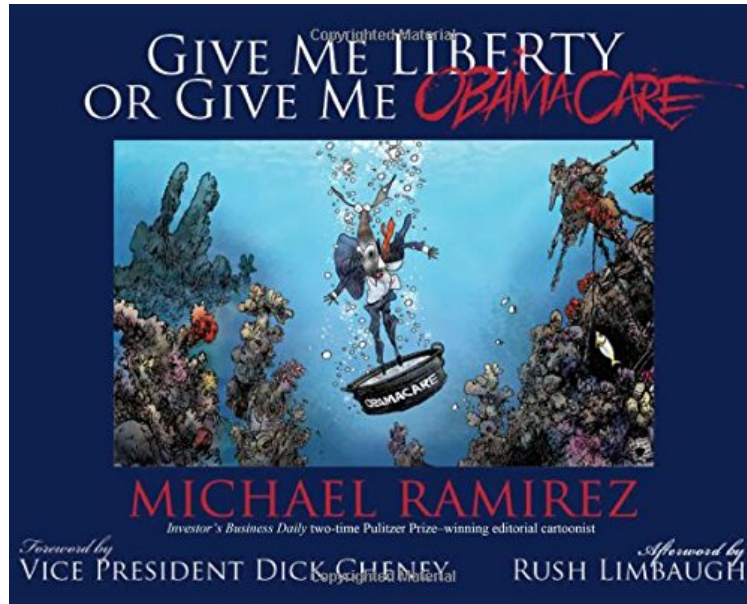

But when I saw that they were collected in book form, I knew I had to order it. I have friends on all sides and in all parties. Most get defensive anytime you try to talk about the logic (or lack thereof) of many governmental happenings. They act like it's a personal attack on them, and it's not. But let them check out this book, and since they don't see it as "in their face", they will see the humor in the cartoon and then they will usually be more honest about what is good and what is bad for the country. Even for the times when they won't change their stance on an issue, they still usually come away at least understanding why I see things the way I do... they "get it", and they don't necessarily think I am wrong.
