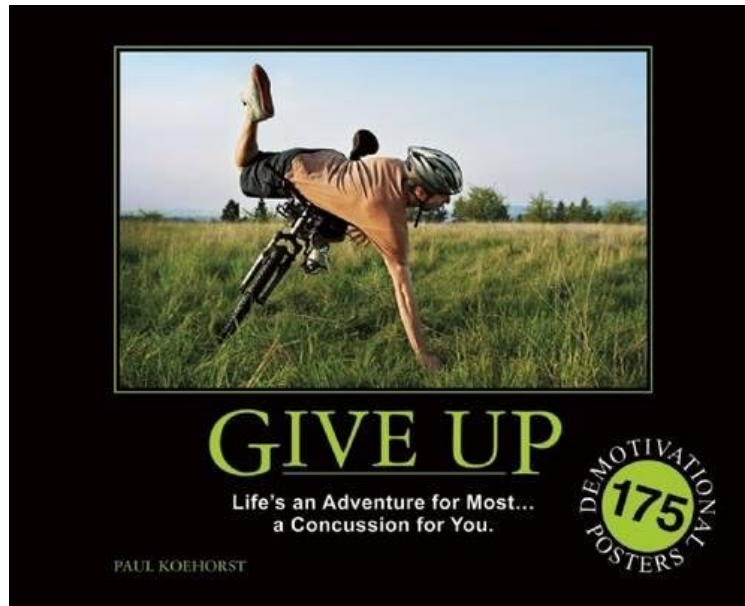

Each page is a different photo and caption and while they're not all completely "laugh out loud" material, the majority will have you wiping away tears. It's not going to change your world or make you see your life in a new and awesome manner, but it will remind you to not be so serious and to avoid four-wheeling.

Do sugar-coated lies and clich photos actually motivate you to do better? Of course not!If you want to get ahead in life, you need to know how things really work. You need posters that reveal the cold, hard truth. You need to be demotivated.By offering demotivational messages accompanied by ridiculous images, the author turns the

motivational message upside down with very funny results. Faux versions of the kitschy motivational poster are already a wildly popular Internet phenomenon, but never have they been done with such savage humor as in this book. The author offers a variety of entertaining options, such as a baseball player eating dirt while missing a fly ball paired with the caption "Humiliation: There's no Point Trying, You Just Look Ridiculous." Another poster pairs a distressed surgeon with, "Failure: Sometimes it is a Matter of Life and Death."
