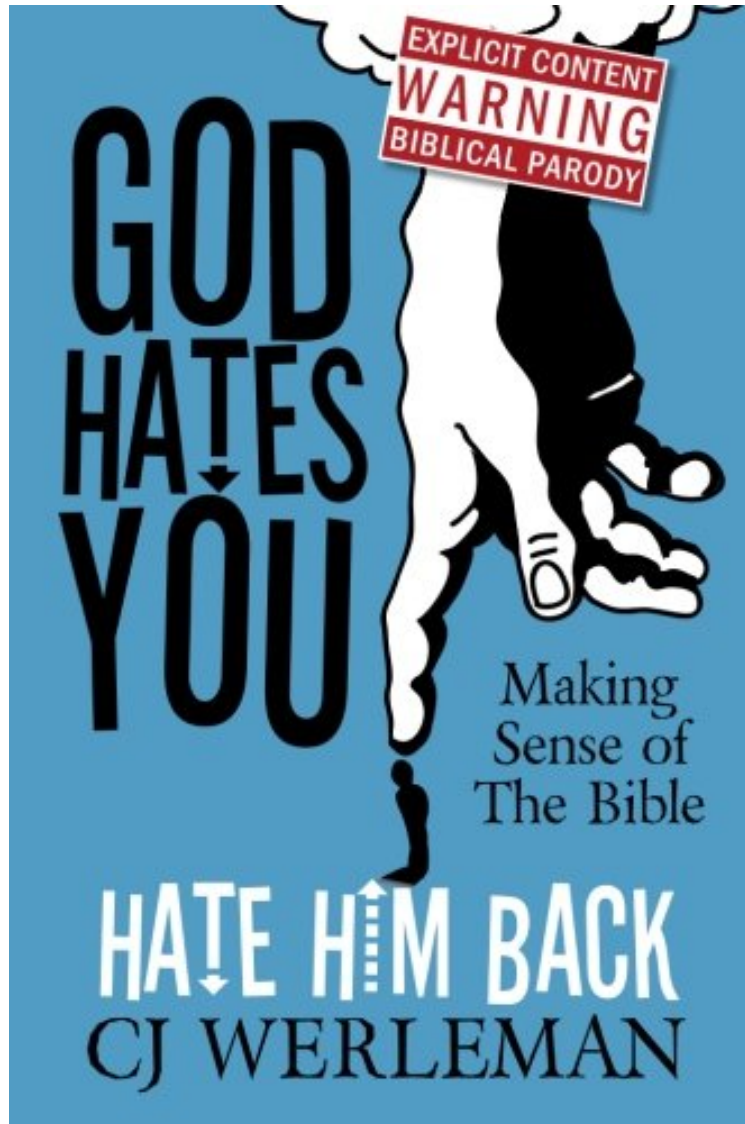

Werleman's book is funny and I do believe that, (pretending god is real for a moment) god hates me.The problem is not with the NIV, as it is essentially the same as the KJV, but with the sloppy editing, and the author's misunderstanding of certain scriptures. For example, the funniest mistake Werleman makes is when he says, "Luke writes of the birth of John the Baptist that whilst he was still a baby: 'immediately his mouth was opened and his tongue was loosed and he began to speak, praising God.'" A talking baby! I almost fell out when I read that. "Luke" was not talking about John the Baptist in that scripture, but John's father. After the angel informed him of Elisabeth's miraculous pregnancy, and Zacharias questions whether his wife's old ass can even have a kid (much like Abraham did with Sarah), the angel Gabriel strikes Zacharias dumb until he names the baby John. So it was after the baby was named John that ZACHARIAS' tongue was loosed.Anyway, this is a funny book, but don't expect Hitchens.
