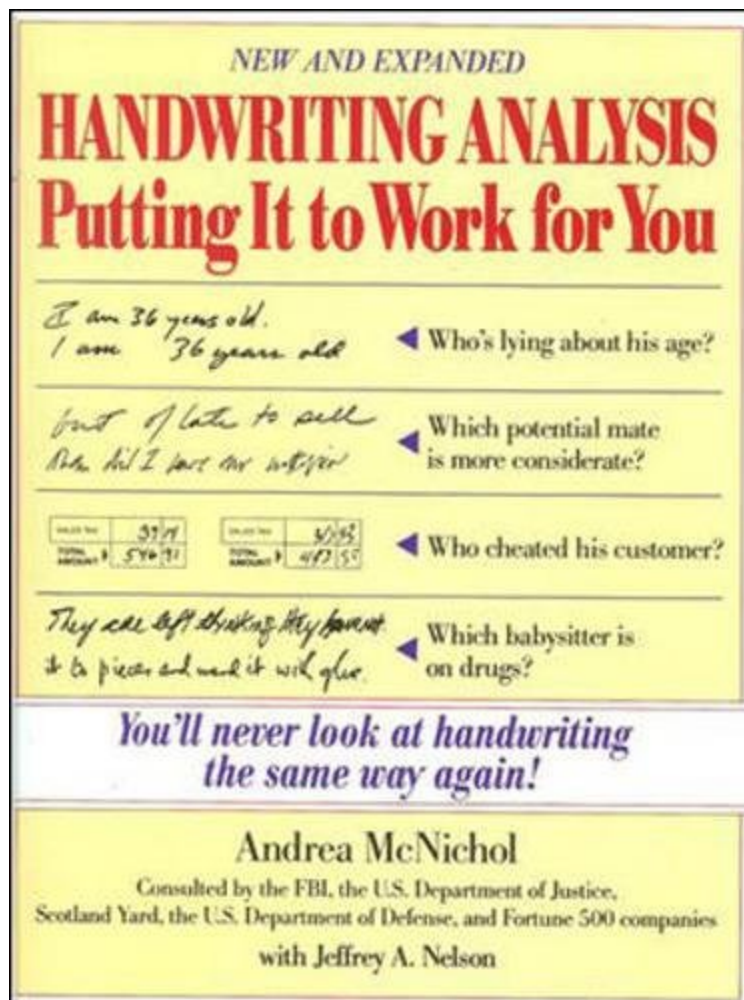

I started reading it that afternoon, and continued into the wee hours, too fascinated to put the book down.In this well thought out and compelling introduction to graphology, McNichol covers each topic in a concise and entertaining way that drives home the common sense and logic underpinning this science. Readers are allowed to reach their own conclusions about each question she poses, before comparing it to the correct answer. McNichol also presents the handwritings of

suspects from real past cases, where she identified the guilty parties by looking at their handwriting. Again, she allows readers to make their own deductions as to which one is the culprit, before checking the correct answer and the reasoning behind it. "Handwriting Analysis-Putting It to Work for You" sparked my interest, and left me eager to learn more. It was the catalyst for my subsequent studies in beginning and advanced graphology, and for my eventually becoming a certified graphologist.
