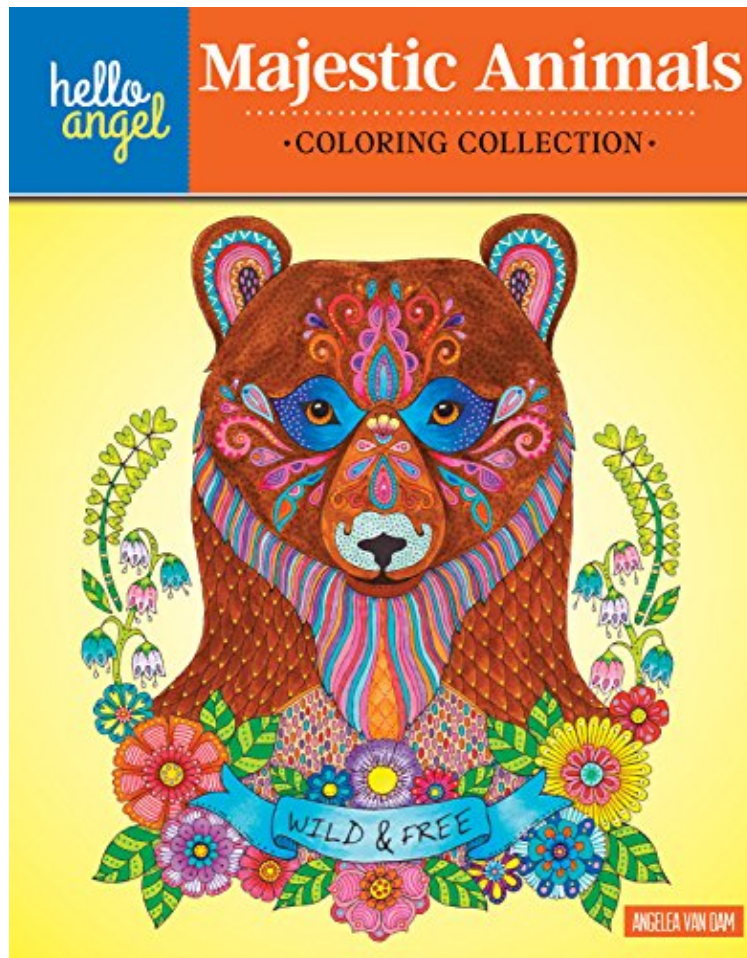

4 of 4 people found the following review helpful. 32 Original and Fantastic Animal Designs – printed on one side of page By iiiireader[[VIDEOID:535499009456f11b51e0c126cf74258d]] When I first saw the three coloring books by New Zealand artist Angelea Van Dam, I had not seen her artwork. I was able to find her website and was amazed by her beautiful illustrations and her artwork. Add to that, these books are published by Design Originals and I know the quality of their books, so it made the decision to purchase them an easy one. There are 32 animal designs in this coloring book. I'm always look for new animals designs as so many now seem to be licensed on-line with the same-old look. With this book, the designs are all fresh, imaginative and simply great-looking. For my first project, I did the panda with my ultra-fine Sharpies. I will provide more detail about what I found in the coloring book below if you are

interested but here is an overview of the book: 32 pages of original animal designs in a "doodle" style. Designs are printed on one side of medium weight perforated paper. Designs stop before the perforations. Back of page has a quote and an area for journaling. Glue Binding. Alcohol and water-based markers and India ink pens bleed through page. Gel pens do not bleed through. Coloring pencils work well. As with other Design Original books, this book includes many examples of colored artwork. It also includes tips from this artist. I found her tips to be of great use. I especially liked her idea of making a color chart to test colors and keep track of them. I also appreciated her suggestion that you continue on with a project that you aren't happy with. It has encouraged me to go back and pull some out that I had packed away unfinished. The designs in this book are printed on one side of the perforated medium weight page. On the backside of each page is an encouraging quote along with several lines on which you can journal or simply note information about your project. The binding is glued but you will want to remove pages at the perforations. The designs stop before the perforations so you will not lose any portion of the design if you remove it from the book. I was easily able to get the book to lay flat for coloring. I will list the coloring medium I used to test this book in the comments area of the review. Here are what my various tests discovered: Alcohol and water-based markers as well as India ink pens bleed through the paper. Gel pens do not but need a little extra drying time. Coloring pencils work well and as expected for brand and type. I was able to easily blend my soft lead pencils. My hard lead pencils left dents on the back of the page. I recommend using a blotter page below the page you are working on to keep ink or dents from marring the design on the next page. You can also simply remove the page from the book before you color your project.

I find myself reaching for it over the 40+ books I have - one of my main go-to books. The paper quality is much better than the average book and the pictures are NOT repetitive patterns which I find so annoying in some books. You can have a lot of fun with these pages by making the animals fantasy like or color them more true to life. I have had no problems with CP or markers bleeding through except alcohol based markers (Sharpies and Blick). I always pull out the perforated page and work on them, one could always put a couple of pages of copy paper if using alcohol based markers to prevent bleeding. I will probably purchase this book again, my Granddaughter wants some of the pictures and I would love to re-color many of them. A great book!

At 21.6cm x 27.6cm and 80 pages, it is a standard size, along with the majority of colouring books, and sits nicely on a shelf or desk or in a bag. The cover is a bright yellow and orange, with a coloured design from inside the book. The glossy card cover is definitely eye catching! The spine is lightly glue bound, and quite pliable, particularly with some use. The paper is perforated however, so it is easy to remove the images for whatever purpose. The paper is of moderate thickness and with a decent amount of texture. Coloured pencils lay down well, and I was able to achieve quite a few layers of both wax and oil based pencils without issue. I experienced a small amount of bleeding and a moderate amount of shadowing with fineliner pens and waterbased markers. Just in case, I always suggest popping a few sheets of paper behind the image you're working on. The bleeding is not an issue however, as the images are single sided. The first 16 pages are full colour articles with hints and tips for various mediums, adding doodles and full colour examples of the pages within. Images Angel Van Dam is inspired by a number of things, and in this particular colouring book, has drawn, doodled and brought an entire zoo of animals to life in black and white. Each image depicts an animal, or animals, decorated with doodles and patterns for you to add colour to and bring to life. Some of these images contain backgrounds, others are repeating patterns, and others are the animal with a small touch of decoration in and around it. The style throughout is quite distinctive. Very realistically drawn animals, with a distinct style of patterns/doodles/tangles added. Each animal has different additions, and this really adds to the charm of the book. The linework throughout remains quite thin, and intricacy is also quite detailed. There are a few images with larger spaces, but the majority do contain intricate areas and small patterns.

Health This is a charming, and cheerful book. The animals and doodles combine to make an image that is a mood lifter - a light, simple image to add any colour you want to. You can stick to more realistic colours, or add in some purple mohawks and stripes if you are feeling like something different. The intricacy and line thickness means that this book most likely will not be suitable for those with vision and fine motor skills impairments. However, I have an intermittent visual impairment and found these images very adjustable. The patterns are easy to incorporate into larger colour blocks if you wish, or to cover up a slip of the hand if necessary. For this reason, the images are a good fit for those with fluctuating concentration levels, as they can be images that you spend hours on, or a short amount of time, depending on your chosen time investment and ability to focus.
