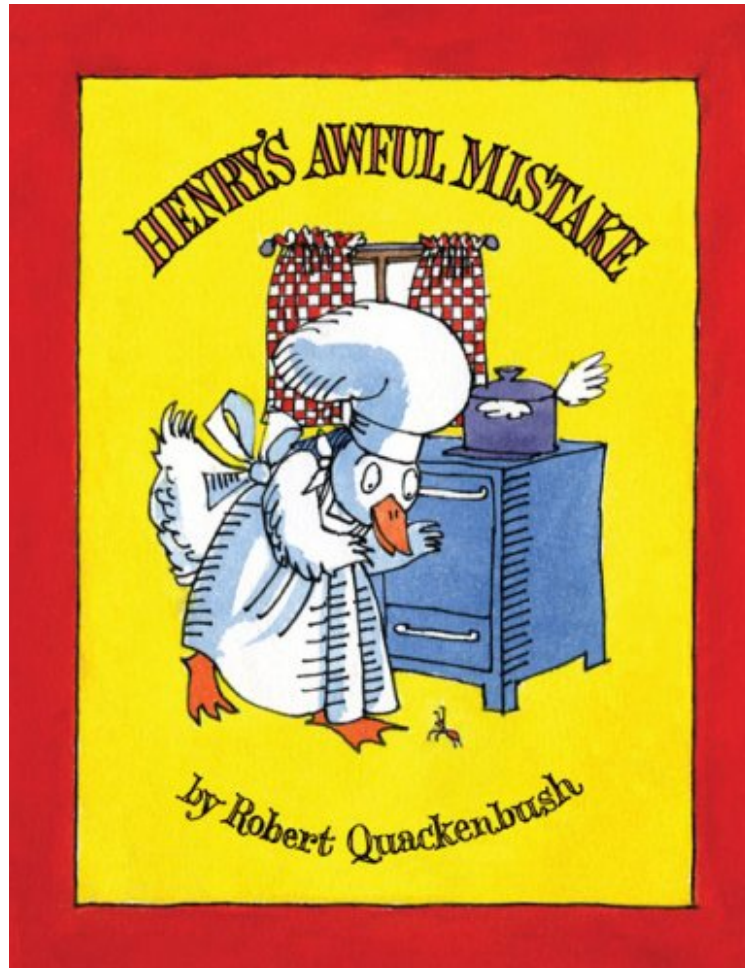

It is a fun story with loveable illustrations.However, when my book

arrived, the pages were warped and some of them were even glued together near the binding. Upon further examination, I found one grammatical error so far. In addition, the text is different from that of the original, and illustrations from the original book have been omitted. I was not aware that this book would be different from the original. My advice is save your money and purchase a 1980 version, which was printed in the good old US of A, instead of this one which was printed in India. The 1980 version is superior, in my opinion.
