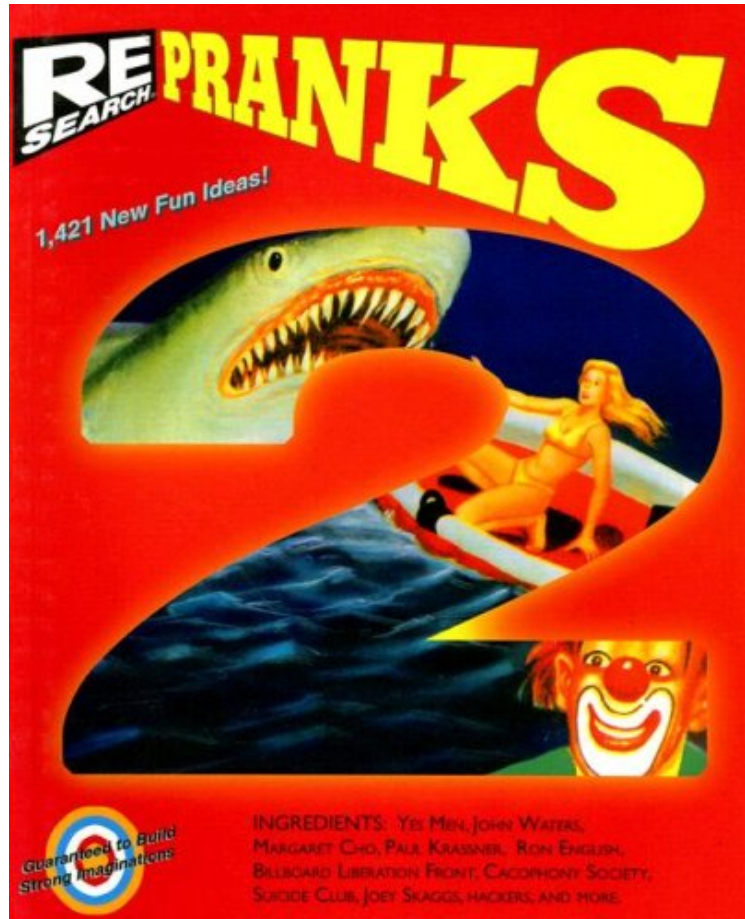

There are some entertaining stories from JELLO BIAFRA, JOHN WATERS and AL JOURGENSEN and some other interesting stuff but not as good as the first book. This seemed like it was put together as an after thought of stuff that got cut from the original Pranks (WHICH IS AWESOME) and lacks the beauty, artwork, and editing of previous issues.
